

Declaration of eligibility

Before signing this declaration, please read the information below to ensure that you are eligible to stand for election.

A person may not become or continue as a member of the Council of Governors if:

- they are under sixteen years of age;
- they are a Director of the Foundation Trust, or a Governor or Director of another NHS Trust or Foundation Trust;
- they are a spouse, partner, parent or child of a member of the Board of Directors of the Foundation Trust;
- they are a member of a Local Authority's scrutiny committee covering health matters;
- being a member of one of the Public Constituencies or the Service User and Carer Constituency, they refuse to sign a declaration in the form specified by the Foundation

Trust of particulars of their qualification to vote as a member of the Foundation Trust, and that they are not prevented from being a member of the Council of Governors;

- they have been adjudged bankrupt or whose estate has been sequestrated and (in either case) has not been discharged;
- they have a moratorium period under a debt relief order applied (under Part 7A of the Insolvency Act 1986);
- they have made a composition or arrangement with, or granted a trust deed for, his creditors and has not been discharged in respect of it;
- they have within the preceding five years been convicted in the British Islands of any offence if

a sentence of imprisonment (whether suspended or not) for a period of not less than three months (without the option of a fine) was imposed on him;

- they have within the preceding two years been dismissed, otherwise than by reason of redundancy or incapacity, from any paid employment with a health service body;
- they are a person whose tenure of office as the Chair or as a member or director of a health service body has been terminated on the grounds that their appointment is not in the interests of the health service, for non-attendance at meetings, or for non-disclosure of a pecuniary interest; and/or
- they are a vexatious complainant.

I understand that I am providing UK Engage with personal data, and possibly sensitive personal data, within the definition of the General Data Protection Regulation. By completing this form I consent explicitly to UK Engage (and any other data processors and controllers it uses) processing any personal data and any sensitive personal data about me for any purposes associated with my nomination.

Where I disclose to UK Engage personal data relating to a supporter or other individual, I give consent on their behalf and have informed them of the identity of UK Engage as the data controller in relation to their data and the purpose (as set out above) for which their personal data will be processed.
