Voting

Voting is restricted to full members and duly appointed proxies. Supporter members are not entitled to vote (if in doubt, contact the Supporter Services Team at <u>membership@vegansociety.com</u> or +44(0) 121 8279905 to check).

Proxy voting forms have been distributed by post and email through UK Engage. The forms include an explanation about how to appoint a proxy in case members do not attend. The form must be received by UK Engage by 13.00 on 19 May. Those attending the meeting and entitled to vote will have been issued with a voting code by UK Engage by email or post and will be able to vote online through a link provided at the meeting. Any proxy appointment they have made will be cancelled.

There will be an audio recording for preparation of minutes. Anyone else wishing to make an audio/video recording of the meeting must obtain permission from the Chair by Friday 13 May.
